

Four PDP Thugs Nabbed With Arms In Ondo State...we hve been videdicated, Ondo LP

Less than twenty 24 hours to the National Assembly elections, four men, suspected to be thugs working for the Peoples Democratic Party in Ondo State were yesterday arrested with cache of sophisticated weapons at different locations in three local government areas of the state.

According to police sources, the arrested suspects were allegedly preparing to commence illegal operations inimical to the successful conduct of the polls when they were nabbed by law enforcement agents.

The first in the series of arrests took place at Legiri Street in Odojumu Ondo Township in Ondo West local government where a car was intercepted inside which seven brand new pump action rifles and cache of ammunition were recovered and the two occupants arrested. One of them gave his name as Lukmon to the Police on interrogation.

Also, another vehicle was intercepted with cache of arms on Isua-Isoani road in Akoko South East Council area by security agents and another cache of arms recovered from him.

In Akure North, one Bayo Igbira, a PDP thug and former NURTW chieftain in the administration of Dr Olusegun Agagu, is now in security custody.

A pump action rifle, spears, bows, arrows and other dangerous weapons were allegedly recovered from him during the arrest.

Contacted, the State Police Public Relations Officer, Mr Adeniran Aremu, an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) promised to get across to us saying he was still being briefed about the incidents. He was yet to reach us as at the time of going to the press

But in its reaction, the Chairman of the State Labour Party, Dr Olaiya Oni said that it has become crystal clear that the PDP cannot win a free and fair election but rather would carry guns and other weapons to steal the peoples mandate like they did in 2007 before God arrested them.

“We have in the last couple of months been alerting the whole world of the sinister motive of the PDP to import arms and ammunitions into Ondo State and visit violence on the people and steal their mandate. This was their antics in 2007 and they are still hell bent of rigging. But we thank God that they are now being exposed and we want to commend the security operatives in the State for a job well done and for them not to relent on their efforts but to rid the state of these vermin, Olaiya Oni Stated
