

# Mimiko Seeks House Approval For 3 Commissioner Nominees

Akure - Governor Olusegun Mimiko of Ondo State has sent the names of three commissioner-nominees to the state's House of Assembly for approval.

The Clerk of the House, Alhaji Jaye Dada, read the letter to the Assembly as directed by Speaker Samuel Adesina at the plenary.

Mimiko's request was in [exercise](#) of his power vide section 192 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999.

The nominees were Mr Niran Akinsuyi, a former Senior Special Adviser to the Governor on Special Duties; Dr Bade Omooloja, a former Permanent Secretary; and Mr Bekekhimi Idhiarhi.

The Speaker directed the nominees to appear before the House Screening Committee at 9.00 a.m on Wednesday for interview.

The executive bill to provide for the establishment of the state's Primary Health Care Development Board was, however, stepped down by the lawmakers.
