

Mimiko condoles with Shema over death of ADC, others

The Ondo State Governor, Dr Olusegun Mimiko has condoled with his Katsina State counterpart, Governor Ibrahim Shehu Shema over the death of five persons including his Aide-De-Camp (ADC) following the unfortunate accident that occurred in the Governor's convoy at Zakaliya Village in Mashi local government council along Katsina-Daura road on Tuesday.

Governor Mimiko who expressed regret over the unfortunate incident commiserated with the families of the deceased and the entire people of Katsina State over the irreparable loss.
