

Ondo PDP, Others Are Irritants – ODSG

Ondo State government on Thursday described the antagonists of the Salary Relativity agreement between the Labour and the state government as a team of sworn enemies of peace and good governance who always use every opportunity to misinform and incite the people against every government action without considering its merits.

Reacting to a publication by the PDP, Ondo State chapter on the minimum wage, the Commissioner for Information, Mr Ranti Akerele asked the party to point to a single welfare package for workers in its 6 years in power except retrenchment and incomplete minimum wage it paid the workers.

“People know those who have conscience and have the love of workers and the electorate at heart. Retrenchment was the order of the day during their reign of terror, throwing workers who voted them into office into the unemployment market while at the same time paying them incomplete minimum wage with the use of government instrument of coercion.

“Although it not appropriate to be dignifying ignoramuses and irritants with reactions to their outbursts, it is however necessary to knock off lies, half truths and falsehood being peddled about to confuse the electorate.

“If not for their laziness, these anti-democracy elements should have spared time to find out the correct financial profile of this administration instead of doing guess work on the minimum wage matter. The present government with low income, had done visible and credible jobs to ease the peoples’ living condition in contrast to heavy revenue collected by them with nothing to show for it.

“Our advice is that they should desist from making false statements when the facts are on the table for all to see else they should remain silent since they can never have any credible contribution to the governance of this state” Akerele said.
