

Mimiko at Redeemed Church parley for politicians, tasks clerics on fervent prayers for nation

Ondo State Governor, Dr Olusegun Mimiko has enjoined men of God not to relent in their prayers for the peace and progress of the country especially as the nation prepares for general election this year. Governor Mimiko stated this on Sunday during a special service for political office holders and the nation at the headquarters of the Redeemed Christian Church of God, 'Throne of Grace' Ebute-Metta Lagos.

This also signifies that the spiritual roles of the church to continue to pray for good governance in this country is being fulfilled in our lives and for us we are very excited and we pray and thank Daddy G.O for conceiving this programme."

In his message, the General Overseer of the RCCG, Pastor Enoch Adeboye charged the people to have absolute faith in God as the only solution to their problem, praying against the emergence of selfish politicians that will not protect the interest of the masses in this year's election.
