

# Ondo To Provide Teaching Aids For Mega Schools

Ondo State government has assured parents and pupils of the newly completed Caring Heart Mega Primary Schools in the state that all teaching aids and learning materials will be provided to aid teaching and learning.

The Labour Party (LP) government in the state promised the pupils that school uniforms, bags and shoes would be given to them free of charge.

The state Commissioner for Education, Barrister Remi Olatubora, made this disclosure while addressing newsmen in Akure, the state capital yesterday at the end of an inspection tour of one of the schools located at Oke-Ijebu area in the town.

The Commissioner also disclosed that a school bus will be attached to each of the schools to make it easy for pupils to get to school on time.

Olatubora revealed that in the next three weeks, academic activities would commence in the Schools, adding that special consideration would be given to the former schools located in the area which were demolished to pave way for the new buildings.

Already, he said, modern seats and tables are being supplied while each of the 21 classrooms had been provided with magnetic writing boards which he said can be used both electronically and manually.

According to him, “we have conventional and e-library where the available computers have been linked with relevant books in Europe and America and three years subscription had been paid already”.

Olatubora noted that going by the locations of the schools in different towns across the state, they are not meant for the children of the elites in the society but every child would have access to the school.
